# Adjustable Rackmount Installation Guide

---

This guide describes the procedure for fitting the adjustable telescopic slide rackmount kit to the Netra 20/Netra™ T4. It also describes how to install the Netra 20 in a Sun Rack.

**Note –** The Netra 20 was originally known as the Netra T4.

## Preparing the Sun Rack for Service

For information about removing the side panels, extension panels, and doors, refer to the *Sun Rack Service Manual*.

## Fitting the Slides to the System Chassis

1. Press in the button on the slide.





FIGURE 1 Dismantle the Slide

2. Pull the glide completely out of the slide.
3. Repeat for the other slide.

- 4. Using four of the M4 × 8mm panhead Phillips screws supplied, screw the glide to the side of the system chassis.**
- 5. Repeat for the other glide.**

## Installation in a Sun Rack

1. Decide on the vertical position in the rack to install the system.
2. Loosely attach the front bracket to the rear bracket using four M4 screws.




FIGURE 3 Securing the Slides to the Brackets

3. Extend the brackets and attach them to the outsides of the front and rear rack mounting rails using M6 screws.

**4. Extend the slides and secure the slides in the required position.**

From the inside, screw the M6 panhead screws into the pem nuts in the brackets.

**5. Push the slides completely into the assembly on each side of the rack and release the stop catches.**

**6. Mount the system in the rack as described in “Installing the System”.**





## Installing the System

**Caution –** The system is heavy. In the following procedures, two people are required to insert the system.



**1. Align the inner glides attached to the system with the slide/bracket assemblies in the rack.**

**2. Push in the slide buttons and slide the system all the way into the rack enclosure.**


